MICHEL PENNEMAN, interior designer, will present his creations

Michel Penneman graduated in architectural drawing from the Institut Saint-Luc in Brussels. He started his career in 1986 in the Tractebel consultancy, then became a CAD consultant for several major architectural firms in 1988. In July 1994 he created his own company, Détrois SA, specialised in creating architectural computer-generated imagery. Parallel to Détrois, he did interior designs such as the Antoine Camus jewellery shop in Paris, Be-fair and the White Hotel in Brussels (in cooperation with the architectural firm A2m). Michel Penneman is continually searching for original concepts. His key words are quick execution, low price, and high-quality lighting and acoustics.

MICHEL PENNEMAN, the projects

An interior designer, Michel Penneman works with several architectural firms, contractors, and lighting and acoustics experts. Their names are mentioned in the projects' references described below.

Tenbosch House (Boutique hotel, with seven spacious suites and swimming pool)

Six suites in two manors, and a contemporary space with a swimming pool and an additional suite.

Scandinavian design is the middle name of Tenbosch House, combining aesthetics and functionalism with an international contemporary art concept. The furniture is Scandinavian from the 50ies and 60ies, and comprises high quality pieces by Hans Wegner and Finn Juhl amongst others. Guests can enjoy a lounge and bar, salon with open fire and a private garden.
